4. Reading and Approval of Minutes from the January 29th, 2005 Technical Committee meeting. Motion to accept with corrections, motion made by Howard KG6GI, seconded by David KC6ZQR, vote 3-0-0
5. Continued Business from Previous TC Meetings:
  1. **146.160 N6WIK** Laguna Hills, Laguna Beach, Laguna Nigel – Follow-up on Final Coordination Review. Documents received from Gary Bakirci (KI6DB). Motion made to terminate the three RFC's from Jeff Towle. A complete RFC for the W6WIK Repeater on frequency 146.160 Hz. located in Laguna Hills will be assembled from Gary KI6DB form submittal and Jeff Towle previous RFC and motion to grant final coordination. The RFC describing a repeater at Laguna Beach will be dropped. The

coordination of a repeater at Laguna Hills in the name of Barbara Towle will be dropped. The coordination for the Laguna Niguel repeater will be coordinated in the name of Gary Bakirci. Motion made by Howard KG6GI, seconded by Lou KG6FCT, vote 3-0-0.

1. **147.915 WB6ZTQ** Camarillo – Change of Frequency (from 147.15) & General Update. 2. **147.180 KK6NJ** Chatsworth Peak – New RFC. Motion to grant an approximate eight month test period to finish 1 November 2005. Motion made by Lou KG6FCT, seconded by David KC6ZQR, vote 3-0-0.
3. **147.210 KE6ZLZ** Sunset Ridge – Letter advising of repeater's sale. Motion made to acknowledge the information by sending seller Glenn R Mc Jennett KE6ZLZ a thank you letter and informing Jeff Stouffer K6JSI by letter that he would have to submit an RFC for the repeater to stay coordinated. Matt W6KGB will send the letters. Motion made by Howard KG6GI, seconded by Lou KG6FCT, vote 3-0-0.
4. **145.440 AD6XK** Sunset Ridge – Letter advising of repeater's sale. Motion made to acknowledge the information by sending seller Steve Mankowski AD6XK a thank you letter and informing Jeff Stouffer K6JSI by letter that he would have to submit an RFC for the repeater to stay coordinated. 9. New Business

1. Coordination 'Waiting List' Report.
  - A. Processing of 'Waiting List' items.
    - a. Chatsworth Peak 147.180 KK6NJ moved to test period, see above. Removed from waiting list.
    - b. Contractors Point RFC withdrawn by requesters John KK6NJ and Joe N6WZK who were present at the meeting for Mid Cities Amateur Radio Club call KF6ZTY. Removed from waiting list.
    - c. RFC from Casey F. Chel KD6DOV for the Long Beach Repeater Associates, Inc. K6CHE denied repeater pair at 145.360 MHz and placed on Waiting list with original request date of 6-28-2004 from RFC. This is the only item remaining on the waiting list.
2. **146.730 K0JPK** Rio Hondo Peak appears to be operating with several PL's one of which is a PL of 103.5 Hz. Motion to send a letter to Carl Moore K0JPK at both listed address requesting the name and address of the person responsible for this repeater because the last correspondence is from 1990. As part of the update process the repeater will be coordinated as having a PL of 103.5 Hz. Motion made by Howard KG6GI, seconded by Lou KG6FCT, vote 3-0-0.
3. Discussion of a phone call to David Tello, KC6ZQR from Al Toll W6JNU of Westminster RACES complaining about interference on simplex frequency 147.510 MHz which is used by Westminster RACES as their primary simplex frequency for emergency and practice communications. Dave KC6ZQR is to talk with Miguel NH2R who is believed to be operating a node at this frequency; and also with Al W6JNU.
